Common Questions

Who should complete this form? The Head of the Household is the person who should complete this form. Many times there are several last names in a household but the family record must have one primary last name. This is the last name used to file your family's records. Different last names can be indicated in the individual's Member information section.

Who should be listed on my record? Everyone residing/living in your home, Catholic or Non-Catholic, should be listed. Adults, such as your parents, in-laws, or others who live with your family should be listed on this form. If they are contributing members of the parish, they should also complete a separate parish Registration form in their own name.

Young adults still living in your home, who are out of High School but attending college should be listed. If or when they are no longer dependents (when they are fully employed) they should complete a separate Registration form.
